

How to claim your Cultural Tax Credit in TurboTax.



On behalf of Oregon's cultural nonprofits, we'd like to thank you for investing in Oregon culture by using the Cultural Tax Credit. This document outlines the steps to claiming your tax credit for those using TurboTax to prepare their Oregon tax return.

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The Cultural Tax Credit is listed under “Uncommon Oregon Credits” in the state return section of TurboTax.
